



FAMILY FLOORBALL CAMP RULES

1. PURPOSE AND VALIDITY OF THE RULES

- These rules set out the rules of conduct, safety, hygiene, and organization of the stay at the sports camp.
- The aim is to ensure a safe, friendly, and fair environment for all participants, coaches, and organizers.
- The rules apply throughout the entire duration of the camp, i.e. from the participant's arrival to their departure.

2. BASIC OBLIGATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

Each participant is obliged to:

- Follow the instructions of coaches and organizers.
- Behave politely and considerately towards all persons and property.
- Actively participate in the camp program, if their health allows it.
- Report any injuries, illness, or other problems to the medical staff or coaches.
- Maintain personal and communal cleanliness and order.
- Follow safety rules during all activities.

3. SAFETY AND HEALTH PROTECTION

- Participants are required to ensure their own personal safety and the safety of others.
- During sports activities, they must use the prescribed protective gear and appropriate equipment.
- It is prohibited to:
 - leave the premises or station without the knowledge of coaches or organizers,
 - bring in, possess, carry, or otherwise handle dangerous items (knives, fireworks, sharp objects, etc.),
 - smoking, consuming alcohol, and using or possessing any narcotic or psychotropic substances,
 - climbing structures, fences, or trees without permission.





- In the event of an accident or illness, it is necessary to immediately inform the coach or medical staff.

4. ACCOMMODATION AND ORDER

- Participants are required to maintain order in the accommodation facilities and at all sports venues.
- Items must be stored in designated areas, and participants are responsible for their own personal belongings.
- The camp organizers and coaches are not responsible for the loss or damage of valuables (mobile phones, money, electronics).
- Damage caused by negligence or intentionally must be paid for by the participant (or their legal representative).

5. MEALS AND DRINKING REGIME

- Participants are required to arrive for meals on time and behave politely at the table.
- The drinking regime must be observed throughout the day, especially during sports.
- Special diets or allergies must be reported in advance to the organizers and coaches.

6. BEHAVIOR TOWARDS OTHERS

- All participants must treat each other with respect and courtesy.
- Any form of bullying, ridicule, physical or psychological abuse is strictly prohibited.
- Participants should inform the coach or organizer of any disputes or problems.
- Participants represent the camp even outside the premises – exemplary behavior is expected there as well.

7. USE OF MOBILE PHONES AND ELECTRONICS

- Mobile phones are allowed – unless otherwise specified by the organizers and coaches.
- Sharing photos and videos on social networks must be in accordance with the consent of participants and organizers.

8. LEAVING THE PREMISES

- Participants may not leave the premises without the accompaniment and knowledge of coaches or organizers.

9. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATING THE RULES

- Depending on the severity of the offense, the following penalties may be imposed:
 - Warning to the organizer/coach.
 - Restriction of participation in the program.
 - Telephone notification of parents/legal guardians.
 - Expulsion from the camp without refund of the participation fee.

10. FINAL PROVISIONS

- These rules are binding for all camp participants.
- The legal guardian confirms with their signature that they have familiarized their daughter/son with the rules and that they will comply with them.
